FELLOW PROGRAMME IN MANAGEMENT (FPM) - ADMISSION GUIDELINES :

1. Introduction

The Fellow Programme in Management (FPM) is a doctoral-level programme aimed at developing scholars and researchers in the field of management. This programme is designed for individuals seeking to pursue careers in academia, research, or industry at advanced levels.

2. Eligibility Criteria

Candidates must fulfil one of the following criteria:

- · Any Two Year Master's degree with at least 55% marks from a recognized university.
- · Professional qualification (CA/ICWA/CS) with at least 50% marks.
- · Relevant work experience (preferred but not mandatory).

Age Limit for FPM Candidates: 35 Years as on January 1st 2025.

3. Admission Process

Step 1: Application Submission

- · Candidates must fill out the online application form available on the institute's website.
- · Required documents:
 - Academic transcripts (10th, 12th, UG, PG, etc.)
 - Valid entrance exam scorecard (if applicable)
 - Statement of Purpose (SOP)
 - Research proposal of 5000 words in Area of Interest.
 - Work experience certificate (if applicable)
- · Application fee payment of Rs 2500/-

Step 2: Entrance Examination

· Candidates must have a valid score in one of the following exams:

CAT /XAT / GMAT / GRE / UGC-NET/JRF

Step 3: Selection Process

Shortlisted candidates will be called for further evaluation, which includes:

- · Personal Interview (PI): Assessment of research aptitude and motivation.
- · LIBA FPM Entrance Test: (Optional, As per institutional requirement).

Final selection will be based on academic performance, entrance test scores, and interview assessment.

4. Admission Offer & Enrollment

- · Selected candidates will receive an Admission Offer Letter.
- · Candidates must confirm their acceptance by paying the admission fee within the stipulated time.
- · Document verification will be conducted before final registration.

5. Course Registration & Commencement

- · Registered candidates will undergo coursework.
- · Faculty mentors will be assigned to guide research progress after completion of the required course work.

6. Program Duration

. The duration of the Program will be a minimum of 4 years and a maximum of 6 years.
